- Can NC-DOT let the town know in advance as to what streets will be worked on? There is no schedule in advance that the town is included in – the TIP gives activity projections on different major roadwork, but minor work is a moment-to-moment action, which DOT cannot alert us to.
- Will there be a stoplight at Depot and Main? Will it be one-way? No decision has been made as yet. The Council is discussing and evaluating how Depot will be affected with the new school but no official decision yet. The general working plan now is that there will be no light but after the school opens, that decision could be changed.
- Is Mickey's opening a restaurant at Guillions? As of now, there has been no word on a restaurant opening there. It's already zoned for restaurant so there could be one there if anyone decides to do so.
- Does Duke Power ride through the town and check street lights that are out or how do we have street lights replaced? Contact Duke Power – or call Town Hall and we will contact them. This is a complaint-driven service.
