

## **Duke Energy Right-of-Way Tree Maintenance in Walkertown**

Line clearance contractors (Asplundh) for Duke Energy will be clearing trees away from our lines in Walkertown from October to February. They will be clearing another one of our circuits that feeds from our Walkertown Substation. This work is required for safety and reliability.

Substation is from Hwy 158 East go 4.6 miles to Hwy 66. Go 1.6 miles, turn right and go 300 ft. turn right into station. Circuit runs northwest up Hwy 311 intersection with Sullivantown Rd. Pine Hall Rd. and Northeast on Grubbs Rd, Old Walkertown Rd, and Salem Chapel Rd. Circuit also includes various streets and major roads which are as follows: Old Walkertown Rd, Salem Rd, Shirley St, Main St, Phillips Rd, Ben Rd, Commodore Ln Rd, Bowman Rd, West Rd, Adams Cir, Hwy 65, Tucker Rd, Hoyner Farm Rd, Stoney Point Rd, Lake Woussicket Rd, Dennis Rd, and Wall Lake Rd.

Our contractors will leave door hangers for affected property owners 3 to 5 business days before doing work on their property.
