## MINUTES

The School Committee convened at 5:10 p.m. with Kim Marshall leading the pledge of allegiance and giving a brief invocation. Present from the committee were Kim Marshall, Arlyn Wilson, and Dana Webster.

The minutes of September 26, 2006 were approved by consensus of the Committee.

### ACTION PLANS UPDATE / DISCUSSION

The Resolution of Support should still be on the Town Council's meeting of October 26<sup>th</sup>. Kim Marshall will get with Lynn to draft the resolution.

The Bond Forum is still on target for October 25<sup>th</sup>. The signs need to be put out! It was felt that some people do not understand what's in the bond – that all schools will benefit from passage; things such as wireless computer labs, etc. Dana Webster presented the flyer to be sent home with students. This is a draft flyer and school approval will be needed before sending out. Dana will try to get approval this week. Kim will have copies made at Ideal Printing then he and Lynn will mail the flyers to the School Board members and to County Commissioners, as well as others, around October 18<sup>th</sup>. Kim will get with area churches to post the flyer and to put in their newsletters. He may send a “blurb” about absentee and early voting, information which, he said, was in the previous council meeting minutes.

### FROM THE COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES OF SEPTEMBER 28<sup>TH</sup>:

“.....That's at the Forsyth County Government Center – Weekdays, it'll be open from 8 a.m. til 5 p.m. On Mondays, it'll be open from 8 a.m. to 7 p.m. On Saturdays – October 21<sup>st</sup> and 28<sup>th</sup> and on November 4<sup>th</sup>, that facility will be open from 9:00 a.m. until 1:00 p.m. And on the two Sundays, October 22<sup>nd</sup> and 29<sup>th</sup>, it'll be open from 1 p.m. until 5 p.m.....”

Donna, with the Chamber of Commerce, and working with School Bond, is looking for volunteers for the phone bank. Mr. Marshall urged anyone with two and half to three hours time available to volunteer. The committee discussed carpooling to the facility but no decision was made. The phone bank will start October 16<sup>th</sup> for certain days and times.

Kim has many temporary signs. He has a list of people to contact to put signs out but he urged the committee to ask everyone they knew to put signs out. It would be especially helpful to put signs out where the traffic flow is heavy.

Mr. Marshall will speak at the Methodist Men's Breakfast at Love's on November 5<sup>th</sup>.
